## **Student Rights**

Whilst undertaking learning with Academy Training & Assessment, you always have the right to:

- 2. Be treated fairly and with respect;
- 3. Learn in a supportive and safe environment free of discrimination and harassment;
- 4. Apply for a refund, credit transfer or recognition of prior learning;
- 5. Have personal records kept private, subject to statutory requirements;
- 6. Have access to personal records on request;
- 7. Be given information about assessment requirements at the beginning of a unit;
- 8. Receive feedback on your academic performance;
- 9. Make a complaint about any staff member without fear of victimisation; and
- 10. Have complaints dealt with fairly, sensitively, promptly, confidentially & without recourse

## **Student Behavioural Obligations**

Whilst undertaking learning with Academy Training & Assessment, you must:
